This information package is to let you know about some exciting opportunities for high school students who are interesting in pursuing post-secondary education in the areas of agriculture, food science or human nutritional sciences.

The following is what is included:

- **Centennial Entrance Scholarship poster** – Each year, the Faculty partners with the Province of Manitoba to offer 11 scholarships worth \$2000 each to high school students who apply to one of the 8 undergraduate programs.
- **G3 Grow Beyond Scholarship poster** – G3 and Agriculture in the Classroom Canada are offering 6 scholarships worth \$4000 each to high school students who are embarking on a post-secondary education pathway in agriculture for Fall 2020 and have innovative ideas the future of technology in the sector. This scholarship also includes \$1000 for the high school that the winner is from!
- **Our Programs postcard** – This colourful postcard gives you and your students a visual overview of our 8 programs. From business to dietetics, we offer academic pathways to nearly every type of career in the agri-food industry. Our new webpage WeFeedYourFuture.ca is a one-stop resource for teachers, prospective students and parents for finding information and booking a tour with one of our Ambassadors. CENTENNIAL ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Manitoba and Manitoba Agriculture are offering 11 scholarships valued at \$2,000 to high school students with an interest in pursuing a degree or diploma in the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences. Applicants must fit into the following criteria:

- Apply for admission to the University of Manitoba;
- Complete 40S-level courses required for admission into the University of Manitoba, from a high school located within the Province of Manitoba;
- Provide a brief letter outlining her or his vision for rural Manitoba and his or her career goals in the agri-food industry and rural economy sectors;
- Provide an updated resume;
- Provide a transcript with most recent/interim marks from their high school; and
- Provide a reference letter from an employer, supervisor or other (not a family member, personal friend or Manitoba Agriculture staff member)
